Introduction, Pagoda Circle

Start Position: Pagoda Circle

Restored Wildlife Habitat

Start Position: Old Stable Bridge

The Master Plan has created a wildlife habitat in this area and returns the Park to a more natural condition. Take a moment to enjoy this beautiful wildlife area on your way to Lafayette Bridge.

New Construction, Fish Hatcheries

Start Position: Near Lafayette Bridge

Learn about some of the new bridges recently constructed in Forest Park and also about fishing opportunities in the park.

Sigel Statue, Wetlands

Start Position: Sigel Statue

Find out about the history of Franz Sigel, a German-American who fought for the Union during the civil war. Also learn about Forest Park's water system as you explore a newly restored wetland area.

Return to Visitor Center

Start Position: Y-Intersection on mown path

As you return to the Visitor Center learn about the many sports and recreational opportunities in the park, and find out more about the ongoing efforts by Forest Park Forever to restore and maintain the park.



iPod Shuffle Operating Instructions Please use only the iPod Shuffle controls on the front. The iPod has three modes: off, continuous play, and shuffle. For the tour to play sequentially, your iPod must stay in continuous play mode at all times. You are in continuous play when you see both green and brown on the back of your device. If you see only green, your iPod is in shuffle mode, which will play the tracks in a random order.

1. Press the Play/Pause (>||) button three times quickly (within one second) to go to the beginning of the playlist.
2. To Play or Pause a track, press the Play/Pause (>||) button once. The status light blinks green for one minute when paused.
3. To Skip to the next track, press the Next/Fast-forward (>>|) button.
4. To Start a track over, press the Previous/Rewind (|<<) button once.
5. To Adjust volume, press either + to increase or - to decrease volume.
