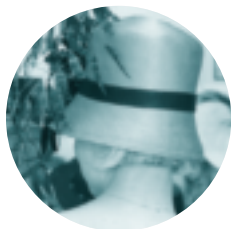

Arrival and Parking Directions

● VALET: Enter the park at Skinker & Forsyth. Drive along LAGOON DRIVE past the Probststein Golf Course. Veer RIGHT up the hill onto FINE ARTS DRIVE. Travel past the Art Museum and make a LEFT onto GOVERNMENT DRIVE. Continue on Government Drive; once you have passed the BoatHouse, make a RIGHT onto PAGODA CIRCLE and another immediate RIGHT onto MCKINLEY DRIVE. Make a RIGHT at the first street to arrive at the Valet entrance, which will be located at the intersection of Carr Lane Drive and McKinley Drive. (Follow the GREEN ROUTE on MAP.)

● UPPER MUNY SHUTTLE: Enter the park at Kingshighway & Hospital Drive. Travel downhill past Steinberg Skating Rink and make a RIGHT onto CLAYTON ROAD. Make a RIGHT onto FAULKNER DRIVE (the Planetarium will be on your left); continue past Jefferson Lake and make a LEFT at the first stop sign, which is WELLS. Veer RIGHT onto MACKLIND DRIVE and continue directly into the Upper MUNY Lot, which is located at the intersection of Union and Macklind Drive. (Follow the LILAC ROUTE on MAP.)

● VISITOR CENTER SHUTTLE: Enter the park at Lindell & DeBaliviere. Drive around the right side of the History Museum. Make a RIGHT at the first street and a LEFT at the stop sign (in front of Dwight Davis Tennis Center) onto GRAND DRIVE. This shuttle will be located on the parking lot directly south of the Visitor & Education Center. (Follow the BLUE ROUTE on MAP.)

Please use these directions to assist you with your prompt arrival and departure. Due to **PARK ROAD CONSTRUCTION** at Hampton and Wells you are strongly advised to avoid the Hampton Avenue entrance.
